

## Flu vaccination timetable 2019

This year there are specific vaccines for specific age groups as below:

| Patient Group  | Clinic start date  |
|--|--|
| Patients aged 65 years and over                          | w/c 9 <sup>th</sup> September onwards  |
| Patients aged 18-64 and 'at risk'                        | w/c 16 <sup>th</sup> September onwards   |
| Housebound patients                                      | w/c 16 <sup>th</sup> September onwards. Please telephone the surgery and your name will be put on the list.            |
| Children in 'at risk' groups (aged 6 months to 17 years) | Will be available middle of October onwards. Please telephone the surgery to add the child's name to the list.         |
| Children aged 2 or 3 (born 1/9/15 and 31/8/2017)         | Will be available middle of October onwards. Please telephone the surgery to add the child's name to the list.         |
| Children aged 4-9 (born 1/9/09 – 31/8/15)                | These should be given by your child's school; the practice cannot do these unless your child is in an 'at risk' group. |

'At risk' stands for anyone who:

Has a long term condition / pregnant / are a main carer for an elderly or disabled person whose welfare may be at risk if you fall ill
